## Dominion Land Grant Information

This map contains the names, dates and locations of the original Dominion Land Grants as issued by the Dominion Lands Branch of the Federal Department of the Interior from 1871 to 1950 and then by the Lands Branch of the Government of Saskatchewan since 1951.

The Dominion Government commissioned the survey of the prairie of Western Canada throughout the late 1860's and early 1870's. In conjunction with the work of the Dominion Surveyors, the Dominion Government began the process of settling the prairie lands and issued Dominion Land Grants (DLGs) to homesteaders. The DLGs were issued to homesteaders who were willing to settle on the prairie lands and were issued in the form of a patent.
